Long-term students are high school age 9-12th grade, primarily Asian, usually remain in the US for several school-years.

MFSE offers excellent orientation and support for students and host parents as well as a network of other host families.

Through our website and e-newsletters host parents and students can: access paperwork they might need, communicate with each other, stay abreast of agency events, etc.

While we do reimburse for hosting, all host parents are volunteers, giving love and time above and beyond any stipend.

Host families come in all shapes and sizes: black or white, suburban or rural, wealthy or middleclass, in large houses or small, with their own kids or without, older or younger. The most important requirement is the willingness to share your home and heart.

All that is required is:

- Reference & background checks
- The desire to host an international student
- A bedroom with a bed, desk or table, and a dresser for the student
- Internet access in the home
- Financial means – although we expect the stipend to cover the student's expenses, families must have the financial wherewithal to host
