

St. Rose of Lima Extended Care Program

The Extended Care Program allows children to experience a rich diversity of growth activities within a Catholic School environment. Activities are planned to complement the philosophy and value system of the school and family. The program strives to construct an enjoyable atmosphere with varying activities including homework time, outdoor/indoor free play, sports and crafts.

All students in grades Pre-K through 6th grade are allowed to enroll in the program. The Extended Care Program is in operation from 3:00 – 6:00 p.m. every day school is in session. The fee is \$8.00 per day per child for registered students and a \$10.00 drop-in rate. Snack may be purchased for a cost of \$0.90/day that will be debited from your lunch account. Those wishing to send snack from home may do so.

DID YOU KNOW:

- Students may attend every school day, 2-3 times a week, once a month or whatever days you need for after school care.
- A schedule is provided every month for registered families to indicate projected days of care.
- The program is in session for early dismissal days (March 19) from Noon until 6:00 p.m.
- If you need to make that hair appointment, doctor appointment or shopping we are available. (I know I used to do my grocery shopping over my lunch hour to avoid all the unnecessary sweets/etc. that my daughter would put into the cart
- Homework is completed at the beginning of every session.
- We play Halloween, Christmas, Valentine and Easter Bingo with prizes.
- Throughout the year the students make chocolate candy, lollipops, and mints.
- We are waiting for the snow to melt because every spring the boys and girls love to fly kites (St. Rose has the perfect hill and wind), blow bubbles, play badminton and enjoy other outside activities.
- On warmer days the program supplies the ingredients to make your own sundaes and the students love the water balloon tosses.
