Thank you for your continued support of St. Rose of Lima School. The cost to educate a child at St. Rose of Lima School will cost \$5, 200.00 this year. The parish is subsidizing \$1,700.00 for each child.

The cost for the first child only is an increase of \$22.00/month over 11 months. There is no increase for the second or third child. The Neumann Scholarship, St. Paul Scholarship, and John DeStephano Tuition Assistance Scholarship, will be addressed Wednesday evening.
