

5th Grade Summer Reading Assignment:

- Read a **Chapter Book** or a **nonfiction book** of your choosing.
- After you complete the book, choose only **ONE (1)** of the following assignments.
- Please bring with you the first day of school.

1. Character Scrapbook

*You will create a scrapbook for ANY 1 character in your book (or relevant items from your nonfiction book)

- A. You will draw and/or cut out pictures of people, events and things that are important to your selected character. (Just as if your selected character was creating a scrapbook.)
- B. You will then paste your pictures onto construction paper.
- C. Attach the construction paper together like a scrapbook.
- D. You must include **20** pictures.
- E. Each picture must be labeled.
- F. In 2-3 complete, well-written, grammatically correct sentences, under or next to your picture, explain how the picture relates to the book and its significance to the character.
- G. Create a cover that includes the title of the book, the author of the book, your name and character's name.

OR

2. Memory Box

*You will fill a shoebox with **real** items that are important and significant to a character in your book.

- A. You will collect **20** items that are important to a character/person in your book. (Just as if your selected character was creating a memory box.)
- B. All items must be real. No drawings or pictures.
- C. Items must fit in a shoebox.
Ex: Car - matchbox car / Horse - small plastic toy horse /
Computer - mouse from computer
- D. Use construction paper and/or other decorative material to decorate the outside of the box.
- E. On a separate piece of paper, neatly list the 20 items you have placed in the box. Next to each item use 2-3 complete, well-written, grammatically correct sentences explaining how the picture relates to the book and its significance to the character. Put the paper inside the box.

- F. On the top of the box cover, glue a piece of paper that includes the title of the book, the author of the book, your name and character's name.
